Additional restrictions and conditions:

- Burning of materials other than natural vegetation or untreated wood is prohibited by Colorado Revised Statutes and EPA Regulations. (Prohibited items include: chemically treated wood, trash, roofing materials, tires or hazardous materials.)
- Burning may **only** occur between the hours of 8am-3pm. A person 18 years of age or older must be present at all times.
- All burning must be conducted in an open accessible area clear of overhead trees and vegetation.
- A water source must be readily available.
- The fire must be completely extinguished and cold to the touch when burning operations are completed.
- Burning is prohibited on **RED FLAG** days, and days when high-winds are forecast.
- All burning is subject to restrictions or bans implemented by the Sheriff having jurisdiction for the area where the fire is to occur. **This permit does not supersede local restrictions or bans.**
- The individual responsible for the fire must notify the local dispatch center prior to conducting burning operations and when burning operations are complete. **Dispatch centers:** El Paso County 719-390-5555 / Elbert County (dispatched by Douglas County) 303-660-7500
- Call 911 Immediately if there is any loss of control of the fire.
- A property owner or responsible party, conducting any burning, may be held civilly or criminally liable for any damages caused by the fire. This permit does not relieve the property owner or responsible party of any civil or criminal liability.
